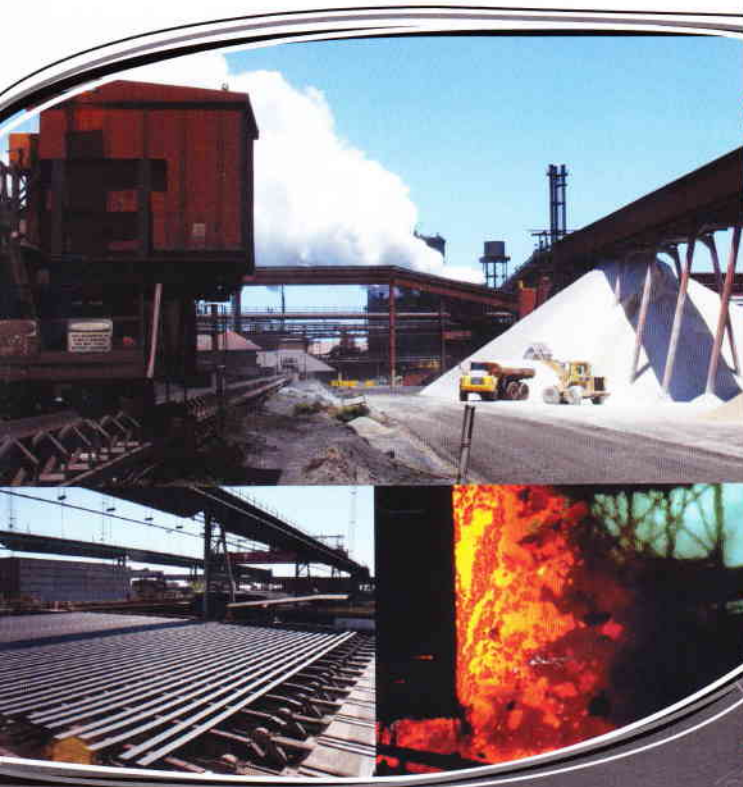

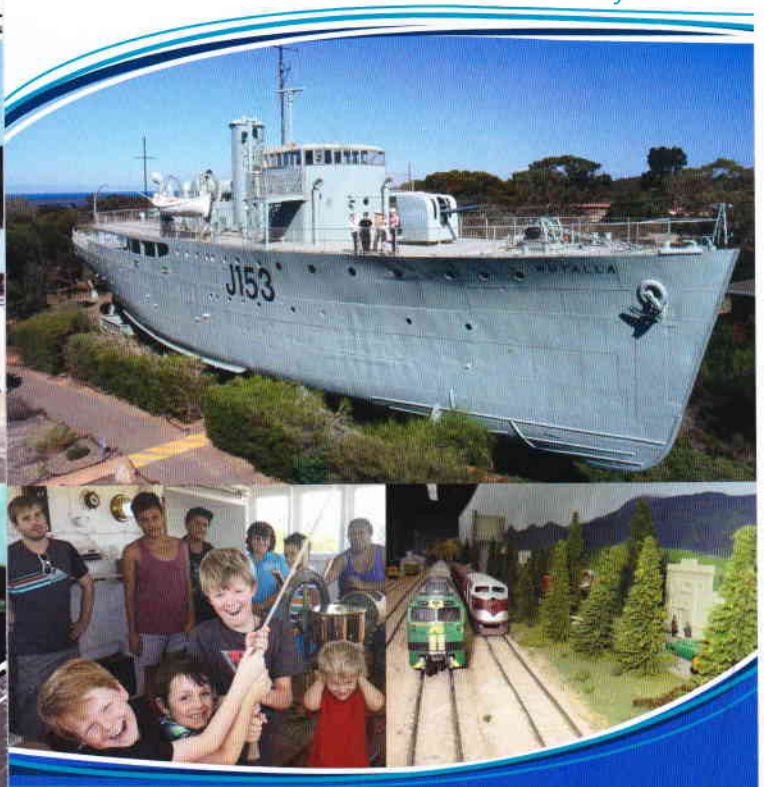

More than a museum the Whyalla Maritime Visitor Precinct celebrates the pioneer ship building history of Whyalla and the spirit and adventure of discovery when forging the industrial development of the area. Set within the lush gardens on the Lincoln Highway, visitors can relax in the tranquil grounds and become part of the story when viewing the HMAS Whyalla, the first ship built in the Whyalla Shipyards in 1941 and the distinctive H0 gauge model railway.
